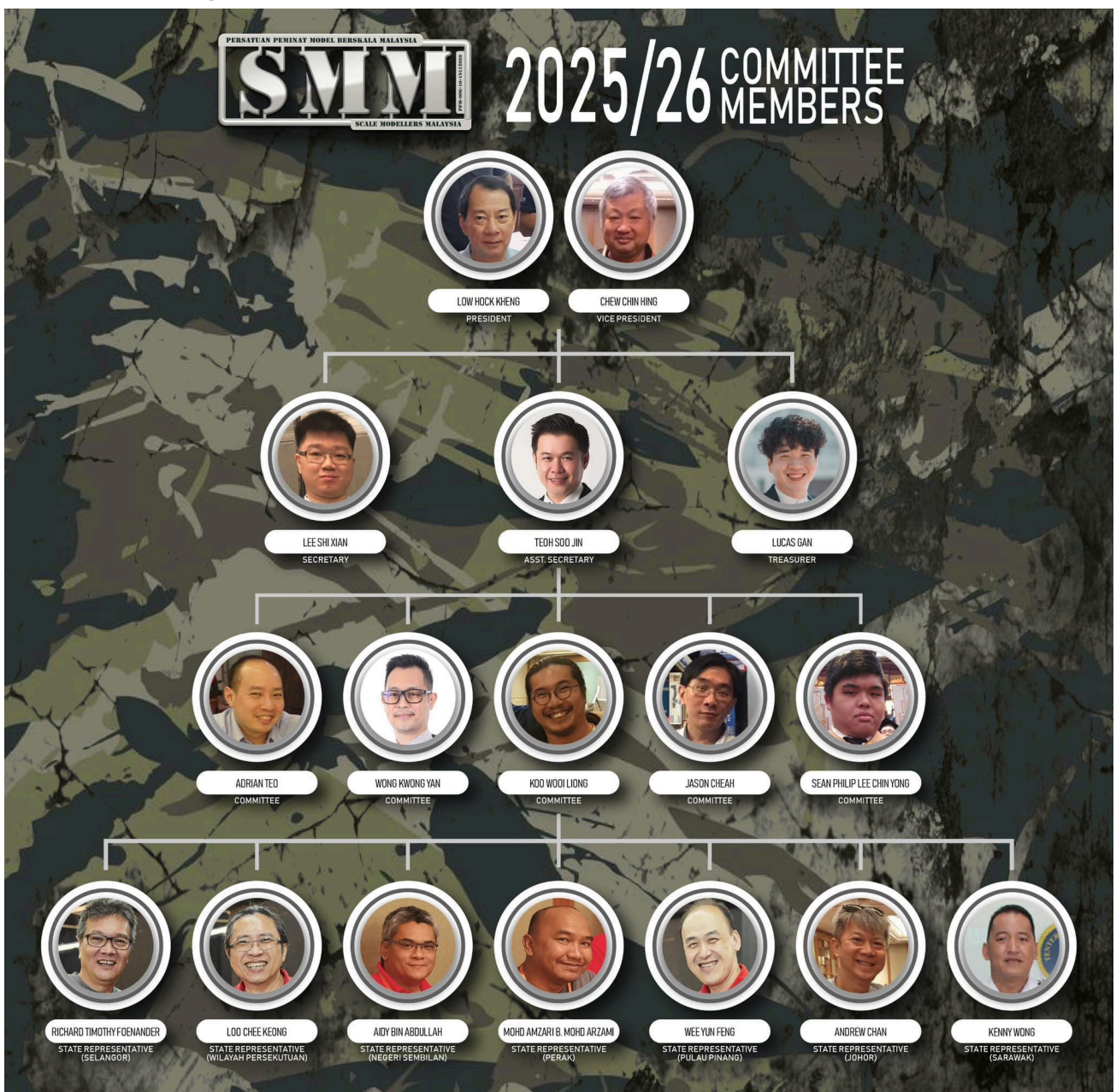

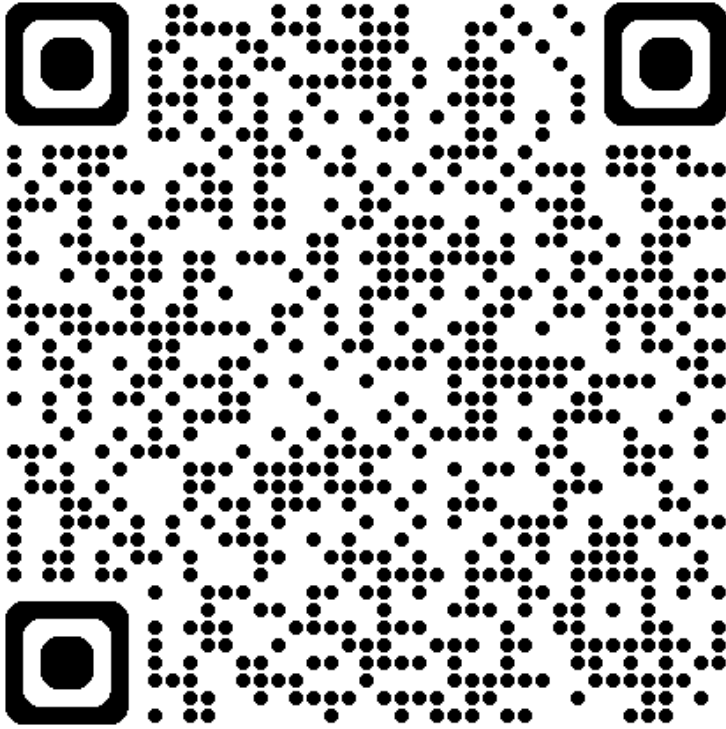

### 2.1 ANNUAL REPORT: TREASURER REPORT

The Treasurer reported that the accounts had been audited by Robert Mengkwai & Loo PLT. The audited financial period covers 30th June 2023 to 30th June 2024. The opening balance was RM7,969.00, and the closing balance stood at RM9,447.00. The net surplus for the period was RM1,478.00, including proceeds from membership fees, events, t-shirt sales, donations, and miscellaneous income

Operating expenses amounted to RM6,216, covering audit fees, t-shirt printing, postage, printing and stationery, service tax, and website hosting

Contributions of RM1500.00 were donated to St Joseph Orphanage, Upper Penang which RM400.00 was collected from the swap and sale meet. Our president chipped in another RM570.00 while Mr. C.K. Loo added another RM530.00

The Treasurer informs that we are to appoint Robert Mengkwai & Loo PLT as our official auditor for the upcoming auditing. The floor agrees.

- v) Mr. Suresh suggested that SMM organize a club trip to "LIMA". The committee will consider this.
- vi) Mr. Fuad proposed organizing more public scale modelling events. Mr. CK Loo explained that current funds do not permit this, but the committee will reconsider once the membership reaches 200 members.
- vii) Mr. Mitchell suggested participating in paid events to promote the hobby. The committee will explore this option.
- viii) Mr. Raymond of Lucky Model flew in from Hong Kong to attend our event and gave a short speech. SMM expressed gratitude for his participation and sponsorship.



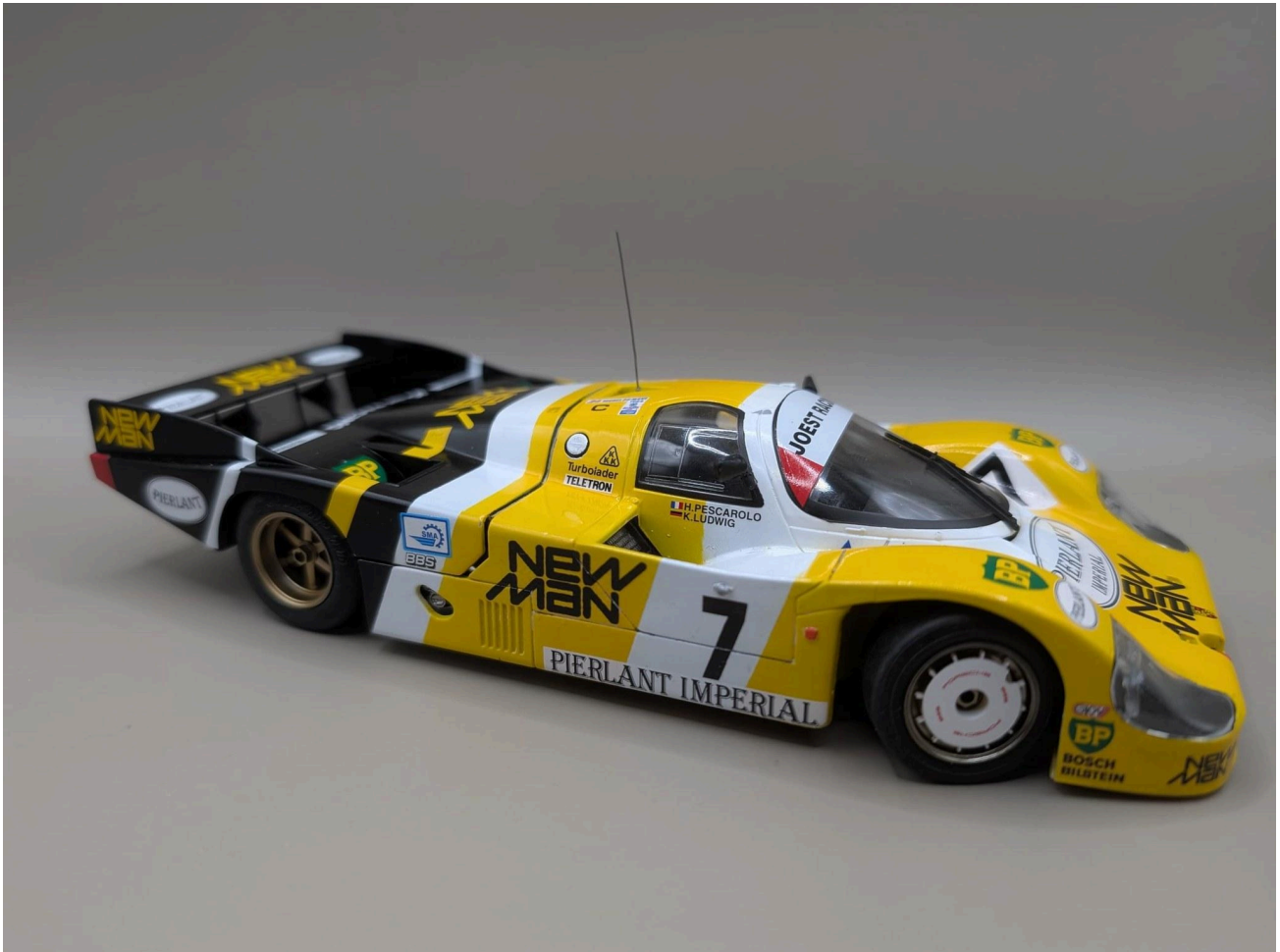

**NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

**1. GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Society is domiciled in Malaysia and is established under the Societies Act, 1966 on November 19, 2020.

The principal activities of the Society are:

- 1) to cultivate interest in the building of scale models, especially scale models in commercial markets, sharing information, experiences and providing assistance as well as advice to members to improve their building standards and techniques.
- 2) to ensure the sharing of up -to -date information on scale models and ensure that any relevant discussions will not be compromised national security and at the same time to strengthen and maintain relationships with foreign scale model associations.
- 3) to share the latest information via electronic publications or announcements.
- 4) to publish articles or major topics that will interest members relating directly or indirectly to the scale modeling, including any relevant current and up -to -date information of hobbies and from the scale model building industry.

The address of the registered office of the Society is 47-1, Jalan Mamanda 9, Ampang Point, Ampang 68000, Selangor.

The financial statements have been authorised for issue in accordance with a resolution of the Committee Members on August 11, 2025.

**2. BASIS OF PREPARATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

The financial statements of the Society have been prepared in compliance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS) and the provisions of the Societies Act, 1966 in Malaysia.

### 3. MATERIAL ACCOUNTING POLICY INFORMATION

#### Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, as modified by financial assets at fair value through profit or loss.

The financial statements are presented in Ringgit Malaysia ("RM"), unless otherwise stated

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with MFRS requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements, and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reported period.

#### Financial instruments

##### (i) Classification

The Society classifies its financial assets as those to be measured at amortised cost.

The Society classifies its financial assets based on both the Society's business model for managing those financial assets and the contractual cash flow characteristics of the financial assets.

The Society classifies cash and cash equivalents (Note 3) as financial assets at amortised cost as these financial assets are held to collect contractual cash flows consisting of the amount outstanding.

The Society classifies payables and provision of taxation as financial liabilities measured at amortised cost.

##### (ii) Recognition and measurement

Financial liabilities, within the scope of MFRS 9, are recognised in the statement of financial position when, and only when, the Society becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the financial instrument.

Financial assets are derecognised when the rights to receive cash flows from the investments have expired or have been transferred and the Society has transferred substantially all risks and rewards of ownership.

Financial liabilities are derecognised when it is extinguished, i.e. when the obligation specified in the contract is discharged or cancelled or expired.

Financial assets at amortised cost and other financial liabilities are subsequently carried at amortised cost using the effective interest method

(iii) **Impairment**

The Society measures credit risk and expected credit losses using probability of default and loss given default. Management considers both historical analysis and forward looking information in determining any expected credit loss. Management considers the probability of default to be close to zero as these instruments have a low risk of default and the counterparties have a strong capacity to meet their contractual obligations in the near term. As a result, no loss allowance has been recognised based on 12 month expected credit losses as any such impairment would be wholly insignificant to the Society.

**Inventory**

Inventory which consist of T-shirts are stated at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost is determined on the weighted average basis. Net realisable value represents the estimated selling price in the ordinary course of business, less selling and distribution costs and all other estimated cost to completion.

**Income taxes**

Current tax expense is determined according to Malaysian tax laws and includes all taxes based upon the taxable profits

**Cash and cash equivalents**

Cash and cash equivalents consist of cash in hand and at bank.

**Payables**

Payables are recognised initially at fair value and subsequently measured at amortised cost using effective interest method.

**Revenue Recognition**

The Society recognises revenue when the amount of revenue can be reliably measured, and when it is probable that future economic benefits will flow to the entity
